Detailed Specifications

Integrated fluorescence spectrometer for steady-state and time-correlated single-photon counting (TCSPC) measurements in solution and solid-state sample from picosecond to second range. Instrument should be capable of automatic acquisition of corrected emission and excitation spectra, synchronous luminescence spectra, excitation emission matrix scan and kinetic studies. Continuously adjustable entrance and exit slits operated under computer control.

Quantity: 01

Optics: All reflective for perfect focusing at all wavelengths from UV to NIR.

Sources:

- 150W or higher ozone free Xenon Arc lamp (continuous source) with proper housing.
- Xenon pulse lamp for longer lifetime (phosphorescence measurement)
- Automatic selection of lamp through software.

Excitation monochromator: Czerny Turner excitation monochromator, to maintain focus at all wavelengths and minimum stray light. Accuracy ± 0.5 nm or better. Range: 200-900nm is preferable. 1200 g/mm grating.

Emission monochromator: Czerny Turner emission monochromator with double grating/faring turret, to maintain focus at all wavelengths and minimum stray light. Accuracy ± 0.5 nm or better. Range: 200-870 nm (preferable) 1200 g/mm grating optimized for 500 nm.

Excitation and emission range: 200-850 nm or better.

Bandpass: 0-25 nm or better, continuously adjustable through software.

Wavelength accuracy: ± 0.5 nm

Scan Speed: 80 nm/second or better

Integration time: From 1 ms to 100 second or better

Detector: Photon counting photomultiplier, range 200-850 nm. Photomultiplier tube in air cooled housing capable measuring signal in the range 200-850 nm, detector should be capable to measure the steady state spectra as well as fluorescence lifetime of the sample. Reference Detector: Silicon Photodiode for excitation correction,

Transmission detector: Silicon photodiode for absorbance measurement. Additional port for future upgradation of detector.

Signal to noise ratio of water Raman Signal: 10000: 1 (First Standard Deviation) or better, ($E_x=350$ nm, $E_m=397$ nm, Band Pass = 5nm, Integration: 1s).

Sample Compartment: Liquid sample holder and front face solid sample holder for thin films, powders, pellets, microscopic slides etc.

Peltier based thermostatted cell holder for liquid sample, temperature range from -10°C to $+100^\circ\text{C}$ or better. Temperature control of cell holder through computer software.

Lifetime Measurement

- MCS or suitable technique to measure longer lifetime from microseconds to seconds. Phosphorescence Lifetime Capability: Measurement of phosphorescence decays in the time range $<5 \mu\text{s}$ to 10 s.
- TCSPC technique based shorter lifetime from picoseconds to microseconds, TCSPC Controller with timing electronics and other required components (hardware and software) should be quoted.

TCSPC sources: (i) Pulsed laser diode at 450nm, pulse width 120ps or lower and repetition rate 20MHz or better.

(ii) Variable pulsed LED sources for measurement of longer lifetime or phosphorescence lifetime. Pulsed LED of wavelength: 275 nm (± 10 nm), 365 nm (± 10 nm), with adjustable pulse width from <80 ns - 50 ms or better.

Computer hardware and software

Suitable computer workstation and all interfacing hardware and software for instrument control, data control, data acquisition, data storage and data processing for steady-state and time resolved data analysis software. Software should be capable of collecting and analysis fluorescence emission decay, anisotropy decay (up to 5 exponential), TRES, MCS lifetime analysis (phosphorescence), global analysis of decays. Routine data handling (normalisation, scaling, arithmetic, integration, differentiation, smooth etc.), File import/export options, including ASCII etc.

Installation and student training is required.

Warranty & Support:

1. 5 years' comprehensive on-site warranty for the instrument (should be shown separately for each year) from the date of successful installation and commissioning. If the system breakdowns during the warranty period, the warranty period will be extended for the full breakdown period after the expiry of initial warranty.
2. Service response time must be within week time.
3. On- site training must be provided by trained engineer free of cost.

Maintenance: The supplier is required to confirm that the spares and accessories would be available for more than 5 years after the expiry of warranty.

Up-gradation: The supplier shall supply upgraded software for the instrument whenever they are available.

Application notes & manuals: The supplier shall provide detailed application notes and manuals of the instrument.

Compliance Statement: The supplier must submit a table indicating the compliance of the features of the model of the equipment being quoted with those given in the table.

Pre-installation requirement: Pre-installation requirements such as room size, required power rating, utility requirements are to be stated clearly, and to be verified/surveyed by the supplier at the installation site. It is the supplier's responsibility to clearly provide details of the above-mentioned requirements before delivery of the equipment.

5. While submitting the tender, if any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any form, the tender is liable to be rejected. If any tenderer stipulates any condition of his own, such conditional tender is liable to be rejected.
6. IIT Patna reserves the right to reject any tender/bid wholly or partly without assigning any reason.
7. The technical committee constituted by the IIT Patna shall have the right to verify the particulars furnished by the bidder independently.
8. Tenderer shall take into account all costs including installation, commissioning, cartage etc. for giving delivery of material at site i.e. IIT Patna before quoting the rates. In this regard no claim for any extra payment for any reason shall be entertained.
9. The item should be delivered at IIT Patna, Kanpa Road, Bihta, Patna-801106, Bihar, INDIA and the supplier shall be responsible for any damage during the transit of goods.
10. All the tender documents & price bid to be uploaded as per this tender are to be digitally signed by the bidder.
11. Interested bonafide and reputed manufacturers/India agents (on behalf of their foreign principals) may submit Online bids for each of the above equipment along with all requisite documents and scanned copy of Tender Fee / EMD submission reference.
12. The Bidder(s) may note that ONLINE BIDS will ONLY be accepted. All the requisite supporting documents mentioned in the bid document should and must be uploaded On-line <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. The Bids sent through FAX, E-mail, by hand and/or by post shall not be accepted/ processed, in any case.
13. The bidders may submit duly filled and completed bidding document ONLINE as per instruction contained in the bidding documents. Incomplete bid shall be rejected. The conditions of tender shall be governed by the details contained in complete bid document.
14. In case, holiday is declared by the Government on the day of opening the bids, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time. IIT Patna reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

REGISTRATION

1) Bidders are required to enrol on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link “Online bidder Enrolment” on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.

2) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.

3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.

4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.

5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC’s to others which may lead to misuse.

6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID/ password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

1) There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.

2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective ‘My Tenders’ folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e- mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.

3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

1) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.

2) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.

3) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

4) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use “My Space” or “Other Important Documents” area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the “My Space” area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

Note: My Documents space is only a repository given to the Bidders to ease the uploading process. If Bidder has uploaded his Documents in My Documents space, this does not automatically ensure these Documents being part of Technical Bid.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

1) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.

2) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.

3) Bidder has to select the payment option as “offline” to pay the tender fee/ EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument.

4) Bidder should prepare the EMD as per the instructions specified in the tender document. The original should be posted/couriered/given in person to the concerned official, latest by the last date of bid submission or as specified in the tender documents. The details of the DD/any other accepted instrument, physically sent, should tally with the details available in the scanned copy and the data entered during bid submission time. Otherwise the uploaded bid will be rejected.

5) Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the white coloured (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

6) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders’ dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.

7) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid opener’s public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

8)The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

9) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after Clicking “Freeze Bid Submission” in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.

10) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS

1) Any queries relating to the tender document and the terms and conditions contained therein should be addressed to the Tender Inviting Authority for a tender or the relevant contact person indicated in the tender.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

01. **Rates:** Rates quoted for indigenous items must be on F.O.R basis for IIT Patna, on DOOR DELIVERY Basis, with break up as per details given in BoQ.
02. **Validity:** The validity period of the offer should be clearly specified. It should be at least for 120 days from the last date of submission of quotations.
03. **Warranty/Guarantee:** The material is quoted with a minimum onsite Warranty/Guarantee period of 05 years after the date of installation and acceptance at final destination.
04. **EMD:** The required EMD should be submitted in the Institute's Account using:

 - c. The bidder seeking EMD exemption, must submit the valid supporting document for the relevant category as per CPPP GTC with the bid. Under MSE category, only manufacturers for goods and services providers for services are eligible for exemption from EMD
05. **Delivery:** Unless otherwise stated delivery of goods shall be at IIT Patna and will have to be effected maximally within **20 weeks** from the date of issue of the Purchase Order. All aspects of safe delivery shall be the exclusive responsibility of the vendor.
06. **PAN, GST Certificates & TDS:** Scanned copy of PAN along with PAN of partners/owners (if applicable) and GST Registration Certificate in Form REG-06 must be uploaded with technical bid. Appropriate tax deduction at source will be applicable.
07. **Dealership Certificate:** Dealership certificate (in case of authorised dealers) and standard Technical literature on the offered products must be uploaded with technical bid.
08. **Performance Guarantee:** 3% in the form of Bank Guarantee/ Fixed Deposit of the total order value needs to be submitted for such period as to cover two months beyond the warranty period for any order for equipment's of more than Rs.1 Lakh. In case of non-submission of BG/FD, an equivalent amount will be retained while payment till the above mentioned duration.
09. **Late and delayed quotation:** Late and delayed quotations will not be considered. In case any unscheduled holiday occurs on prescribed closing/opening date, the next working day shall then automatically be the prescribed date of closing/opening of the quotation with no change in timing.
10. **Ground for Rejection of Quotation:**
 - (i) The quotations are liable to be rejected if the foregoing conditions are not complied with. The quotation should be complete in all respects if a firm quotes NIL charges / consideration, the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and will not be considered. The quotations shall be rejected if the information is not provided as per the tender documents

(ii) Either OEM or its sole representative is allowed to bid. In case both have bid, the bid of OEM will be valid.

(iii) If at any time of tender, cartelization is found, the bidding firms would be liable for legal action as per Anti-Competitive Practices (CCI).

11. **Payment:** Payment will be made within 30 days from the date of submission of Invoice after successful delivery and acceptance of goods at IIT Patna (successful installation in case of machinery, equipments or the likes) generally through RTGS / FUND TRANSFER. Following information must be clearly written in the uploaded bank details for RTGS / FUND TRANSFER: -

a) Name of the Firm with complete postal address (b) Name of the Bank with Branch where the Account exist (c) IFSC CODE (d) ACCOUNT No. (e) PAN No. (f) GST No.

12. The bidders can quote only those products in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and has at least 03 year's residual market life.

13. **Liquidated Damage:** If a firm accepts an order and fails to execute the order in part or in full, as per the terms and conditions stipulated in the Purchase Order, it will be open to the institute to recover the liquidated damages from the firm at the rate of 0.5% per week of the order value subject to a maximum of 10% of the order value. It will also be open to the institute alternatively, to arrange procurement of the required stores from any other source at the risk and expense of the defaulter firm/vendor, which accepted the order but failed to execute the order according to the stipulated agreed upon. Defaulter vendor(s)/ firm(s) are also liable for blacklisting.

14. **Termination for default:** Default is said to have occurred

(a) If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the goods/ items/ services within the time period(s) specified in the purchase order or any extension thereof granted by IIT Patna.

(b) If the supplier fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the contract

(c) If the vendor, in either of the above circumstances, does not take remedial steps within a period of 30 days after receipt of the default notice from IIT Patna (or takes longer period in spite of what IIT Patna may authorize in writing), IIT may terminate the contract / purchase order in whole or in part. In addition to above, IIT Patna may at its discretion also take the following actions: IIT Patna may procure, upon such terms and in such manner, as it deems appropriate, goods similar to the undelivered items/products and the defaulting supplier shall be liable to compensate IIT Patna for any extra expenditure involved towards goods and services to complete the scope of procurement.

15. **Applicable Law:**

(a) The contract shall be governed by the laws and procedures established by Govt. of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such Commercial dealings / processing, as may be applicable upon IIT Patna.

(b) All disputes are subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Competent Court and Forum in Patna, India only.

(c) Any dispute arising out of this purchase shall be referred to the Registrar IIT Patna, and if either of the parties hereto is dissatisfied with the decision, the dispute shall be referred to the decision of an Arbitrator, who should be acceptable to both the parties, (to be appointed by the Director of the Institute). The decision of such Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

16. The acceptance of the quotation will rest solely with the **Director**, IITP, who in the interest of the Institute is not bound to accept the lowest quotation and reserves the right to himself to reject or partially accept any or all of the quotations received without assigning any reason(s).

17. **Important:** The **Director** may accept or reject any or all the bids in part or in full without assigning any reason and doesn't bind himself to accept the lowest bid. The institute at its discretion may change the quantity / upgrade the criteria / drop any item, at any time before placing the Purchase Order.

18. **Force Majeure:** The Supplier shall not be liable for forfeiture of its performance security, liquidated damages or termination for default, if and to the extent that, its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of an event of Force Majeure.

(i) For purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means an event beyond the control of the Supplier and not involving the Supplier's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but are not

limited to, acts of the Purchaser either in its sovereign or contractual capacity, wars or revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions and freight embargoes.

(ii) If a Force Majeure situation arises, the Supplier shall promptly notify IIT Patna in writing of such conditions and the cause thereof. Unless otherwise directed by the Purchaser in writing, the Supplier shall continue to perform its obligations under the Contract as far as is reasonably practical, and shall seek all reasonable alternative means for performance not prevented by the Force Majeure event.

19. The in general Printed conditions of supply of the firm, if any, will not be binding on the Institute.
20. The bidders can quote only items with not less than 20% domestic value additional/local content. Local content means the amount of value added in India which shall be the total value of the item procured (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all custom duties) as a proportion of the total value, in percent. The bidders are required to furnish a self-certificate regarding the items meeting local content requirement, mandatorily mentioning following:
 - a. Percentage of Local Content (exclusive of services such as transportation, insurance, installation, commissioning, training and after sales services support like AMC/CMC etc.)
